The Authority of the Believer

I. Definitions

- A. Authority: the right or power to act, command, enforce laws, exact obedience, determine or judge.
- B. AUTHORITY - the power or right to do something, particularly to give orders and see that they are followed. The word authority as used in the Bible usually means a person's right to do certain things because of the position or office he holds. This word emphasizes the legality and right, more than the physical strength, needed to do something.
