A New Look at God's Plan for the Church General Course Outline

COURSE OBJECTIVE: To bring a fresh, prophetic perspective on God's plan and purpose for His church. Our purpose in this class is to challenge some of our traditionally held concepts and to ask some questions about the foundational basis for many of our firmly held beliefs. Our desire is to see the saints of God fully equipped for the work of the ministry, with full knowledge of God's plans and purposes.
