## Hearing the Voice of God General Course Outline

**COURSE OBJECTIVE:** With the abundance of teaching resources available to the Body of Christ, many Christians have come to rely on the revelation of others to discern what God is speaking into their lives. While what God has spoken to others may be useful, it is still only information unless God breathes upon it and we hear Him speaking to our hearts. Further, with the increasing acceptance of personal prophecy, there is a growing tendency to seek "the word of the Lord" from those who have developed their own ability to hear from God. Again, while this can be valuable, depending solely on others to hear God on our behalf will inevitably lead to confusion and idolatry. Our desire is that this course will foster in the students a greater desire and ability to discern God's voice for themselves.
