7 Hebrew Words Translated "Praise"

I. Praise - a generic word

A. The words translated praise, are **not** the only valid expressions of praise, they are words that describe a general attitude as opposed to a specific expression.

II. The seven words - in order of frequency

NOTE: Frequency refers to how frequently the word was translated "praise" in the King James Bible, not the frequency of occurrence in the Old Testament. For example, of the 7 words, "barak" occurs more times than any of the others (330) in the Old Testament, but is only translated "praise" twice. Its most frequent translation is "bless" (302 times).
