So many of the precious young people from all over the city, who were like adopted kids to us, are now adults and have children of their own! We will be preaching, praying prophetically over people and places, encouraging the brethren, touching base with a number of pastors, and also doing some counseling.

FYI: The state of Sonora is a desert state in the NW part of the Mexico mainland. It borders on the Sea of Cortez (or Gulf of California) and is below Arizona. We will be in an area 5-6 hours south of the border.

Tanzania – Spring 2019

The primary tickets for the ministry in Tanzania, East Africa, have now been purchased! Tickets remain to be purchased for the Dar es Salaam to Mbeya Town leg, but that's a domestic flight, and we are not able to get those until after first of year. We will be in Tanzania for 3 weeks holding 5 pastors conferences and one youth equipping seminar around the Mbeya region (over 2.7 million people). Lifeline has been asked to supply the funds for 100 Kiswahili Bibles to hand out to the pastors who do not have a Bible (FUNDS ALREADY RECEIVED – thank you!!), and to cover most of the conference expenses, including feeding the pastors and their wives. The Mbeya Region Association of Pastors is sponsoring these conferences, but they have little in the way of funds towards these expenses. Thank you for any way you can help us in blessing these precious men and women of God!!
